Britta Heidi Cianferoni was born in 1973 in Germany, where she began her first studies in art and advertising design. In 1992 she moved to Paris and graduated in Plastic Art at the Sorbonne in Paris. Her first works are strongly inspired by journeys in the Caribbean, in Polynesia, in South America and Africa, figurative and very colourful. Almost all of these paintings are in private collections.

Currently, the artist seeks a synthesis of color, light and material speaking the language of poetry.

A strong energy emanates from her paintings by a constant play between contrasting bright colors and delicate shades and mix with natural materials like wood and stones and sand paper.
